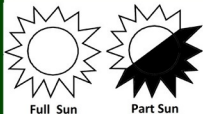


## *Pseudosasa japonica* 'Arrow'

### Arrow Bamboo

Most often grown for showcasing its impressive structure and rich green foliage. It is one of the most useful and commonly used bamboos for hedges or screens. May be grown outdoors or indoors in containers.

Best grown in moist, relatively fertile, well-drained soils in full sun to part shade. Tolerates full shade. Perhaps best sited in sunny areas with some afternoon shade in hot summer climates. Grows in a variety of soils.

# Amelanchier x grandiflora 'Autumn Brilliance'

## Autumn Brilliance Serviceberry

-In early to mid-spring this tree is adorned with clusters of star-shaped, white flowers. They are both delicate and showy, and larger than other varieties of serviceberries.

-Small, round, edible berries follow the flowers. These berries are deep purple at maturity and have a sweet flavor.

-Perfect as a specimen tree in small gardens, hedges, and screens. Also great for wildlife gardens due to the attractive berries.

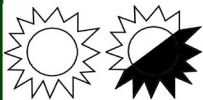


## Cryptomeria japonica 'Black Dragon'

### Black Dragon Japanese Cedar

Prefers a well-draining, slightly acidic, fertile soil. However, this tree is fairly adaptable to any soil that drains well, including clay and sand.

Plant as a focal or specimen tree in a lovely Japanese-inspired Zen garden. Mix with Japanese Maples and Junipers for outstanding year-round color and texture. Also great for rock gardens, compact urban gardens, or containers.

## Acer rubrum 'Brandywine'

### Brandywine Red Maple

-This medium-sized deciduous tree is native to Eastern North America. The new growth emerges red or tinged with red, and the fall color of the leaves is a bright red. Flowers appear before leaves in late winter to early spring (March-April), followed by fruit which is a two-winged samara. Both seeds and flower buds are a highly attractive food source for many species of birds.

-This tree would make an excellent specimen plant for the lawn, making it perfect if you're looking for a shade tree. It does, however, have a flattened, shallow root system that may buckle sidewalks or driveways if planted too close.

This plant prefers full to partial sun and protection from the cold winter winds. It performs best in moist, well-drained soils, and is intolerant to poorly drained soils. It can grow in heavy clay and nutritionally poor or very acidic soils.

Prune in the winter as needed to maintain its shape.

The ornamental English holly is effective as a specimen plant, grouped as a tall hedge or foundation planting. The foliage and fruit provide winter interest.

## Cercis canadensis

### Eastern Redbud

-This deciduous, multi-trunked tree is known for its stunning pea-like rose-purple flowers which bloom profusely on bare branches in early spring (March-April) before the foliage emerges. The flowers are followed by flattened leguminous bean-like dry seedpods that mature to brown in the summer, which may remain on the tree into winter.

-Perfect for specimen plantings, small groups, woodland margins, shrub borders, or along patios.

## Cercis canadensis 'Flame Thrower'

### Redbud Flame Thrower

Redbuds will grow in full sun to part shade, are pH tolerant and do well in moist average well-draining soils.

Use as a specimen, accent or understory tree. Great for small yards.

Leaves show a dynamic transition of color change from the time of leaf emergence and throughout the growing season. Leaves emerge purple and quickly turn to red as they expand. As an individual leaf matures, it transitions from purple to red to reddish-bronze and ultimately yellow-green.

## Cercis canadensis 'Forest Pansy'

### Forest Pansy Redbud

This deciduous tree has rosy-pink flowers that bloom before the foliage in spring, and are on display for several weeks, before broad, heart-shaped, red-purple leaves come in. The foliage turns shades of orange, bronze, and purple in the fall, making this tree a perfect choice for a specimen plant, with multiple seasons of interest.

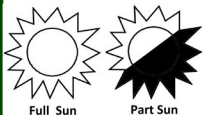


## Cupressus macrocarpa 'Wilma'

### Nellie Stevens Holly

Use this plant as a specimen or take advantage of its dense, prickly foliage for use as a barrier, hedge, or screen planting. It is excellent in a woodland garden or as part of a foundation planting. The showy red fruits add color high in the back of a border. A heavy display of showy red berries makes for great winter interest in any garden.

Does well in full sun to partial shade, preferably with some protection from afternoon sun to prevent leaf scorch. It needs rich, acidic, well-drained soil but tolerates a range of soil types including heavy clay. It is best to avoid wet sites.

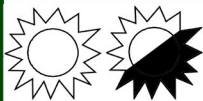


## Acer palmatum 'Orangeola'

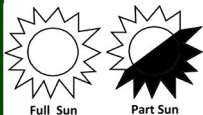

Performs best in part shade, in evenly moist, well-drained soils. It can tolerate full sun but tends to be denser. No routine pruning is necessary, unless it is to remove any diseased, damaged, congested, or crossing shoots.

Good for use as a specimen near lawns and patios, in shrub borders, woodland gardens, or natural areas.

Profuse star-like blooms appear usually before the leaves in spring, which give way to orange-red fruit in the summer.

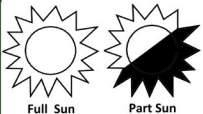
## **Acer palmatum 'Sango Kaku'**

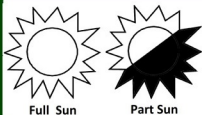


## Ginkgo biloba 'Menhir'

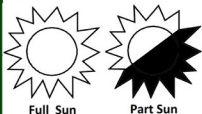
