Carolina Jasmine

- This native shrub has sweet-scented yellow flowers that bloom from February to May. The foliage will turn bronze in winter.
- If trained to an arbor or trellis may grow from 12-20' high. If left unsupported it creates a bushy ground cover.
- Can be used in privacy plantings, native gardens, pollinator gardens, and as a specimen planting.

Encourage the vines to climb up support posts or trellis by twirling the young stems around the base of the posts.

Flirty Girl False Hydrangea Vine

New growth comes in purple before turning green when it matures. Can be used to cover walls, fences, and arbors as a screen or a specimen plant.

Little pruning is required unless it is to keep the plant in the available space.

This plant does better in part shade in warmer climates.

Lonicera x heckrottii 'Gold Flame'

Gold Flame Honeysuckle

Excellent choice for covering walls, fences, trellises, arbors, and pergolas.

Plant in full sun in well-draining soil. Water regularly for the first year to help establish the root system; however, you do not want to overwater it. Prune annually to control size.

Typically, goldflame honeysuckle blooms June through August, but can bloom into early fall in warmer climates.

Clematis 'Jackmanii'

Jackman's Clematis

Can be trained to climb a wall, trellis, fence, arbor, porch, etc. Also great for sprawling over shrubs, old stumps, containers, or small gardens.

Grow in fertile, medium moisture, well-drained soils in full sun to part shade. Vining hybrids are best sited in locations where the flowering parts of the vine are in sun to part shade but the roots are shaded.

oots should be kept cool, shaded and uniformly moist.

Train this easy to grow cultivar along a trellis or pergola for a beautifully fragrant privacy screen.

-This deciduous climber has masses of sweetly fragrant, pure white flowers from late summer to fall, covering the foliage of bright green leaves. After flowering, plume-like seedheads are left, providing winter interest.

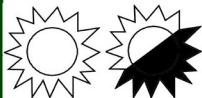
Passiflora caerulea

-Perfect for planting against arbors, pergolas, trellises, as a ground cover, and against walls and fences.

Rose Sensation Japanese Climbing Hydrangea

-This climbing shrub has dark pink blooms that show themselves from early to late summer. Pruning is not usually necessary, but it may be trimmed in late winter if needed.

-Perfect for use in woodland gardens, as a specimen plant, and can be trained to climb walls, trees, and chimneys.

Clematis paniculata

Sweet Autumn Clematis

Landscape uses include arbors, pergolas, trellises, walls, fences, courtyards, cottage gardens, and informal gardens.

Thrives in moist, well-drained soils, in full sun or part shade. Ideally, clematis prefer having their "heads in the sun and feet in the shade." So keeping the roots cool and shaded is key.

Campsis radicans

Trumpet Vine

-Bright, showy, orange-red flowers appear in clusters throughout the summer, attracting hummingbirds. Vines must be grown on sturdy structures because mature plants produce considerable weight.
